1. RACE TRACK CASINOS

SB 525 – Lafleur – De-regulation of gambling: Increases race track casino gambling capacity. Currently based on size of gambling area, proposed law changes to number of machines. Yes(X) = 69 No(✓) = 19 Absent(A) = 17 LFF Opposed. Status: Signed by the Governor

2. ADOPTION OPTION ACT

HB 449 – Edmonds – Incorporates adoption information as part of the Woman’s Right to Know informed consent before abortion.

Yes(✓) = 97 No(X) = 0 Absent(A) = 8 LFF Supported. Status: Signed by the Governor

3. NO PUBLIC FUNDS FOR ABORTION

HB 891 – Hoffmann – Entities that perform abortions in La. are prohibited from receiving public funding.

Yes(✓) = 90 No(X) = 3 Absent(A) = 12 LFF Supported. Status: Signed by the Governor

4. RIVERBOAT GAMBLING - "LANDBOATS"

SB 316 – Johns – De-regulation/Expansion of gambling: Allows riverboats to establish facilities anywhere on land within 1200 feet from water and removes maximum amount of space that can be used for gambling.

Yes(X) = 53 No(✓) = 42 Absent(A) = 10 LFF Opposed. Status: Signed by the Governor

5. FREE SPEECH

SB 364 – Ward – Protects freedom of speech, expression and association at public universities and protects belief-based student organizations.

Yes(✓) = 58 No(X) = 26 Absent(A) = 21 LFF Supported. Status: Signed by the Governor

6. CHURCH SAFETY ACT

SB 402 – Riser – Allows paid or volunteer security guards with concealed carry permits to carry a firearm in church.

Yes(✓) = 81 No(X) = 10 Absent(A) = 14 LFF Supported. Status: Signed by the Governor

7. GOOD GOVERNMENT

HB 88 – Mack – Makes it a crime to defraud the state to obtain government benefits or payments.

Yes(✓) = 75 No(X) = 20 Absent(A) = 10 LFF Supported. Status: Signed by the Governor

8. DECREASING DEMAND FOR PROSTITUTION

SB 335 – Mizell – Increases fines and provides education for those who purchase commercial sex (prostitution).

Yes(✓) = 67 No(X) = 23 Absent(A) = 15 LFF Supported. Status: Signed by the Governor

9. SCHOOL CHOICE

HB 487 – Zeringue – 529 college savings can now be used to pay tuition at elementary or secondary public, private, or religious schools and extends START program state matching funds. (Current La. law restricts to higher ed.)

Yes(✓) = 49 No(X) = 44 Absent(A) = 12 LFF Supported. Status: Failed House Final Passage

10. ABORTION PROHIBITION AFTER 15 WEEKS

SB 181 – Milkovich – Prohibits abortions after 15 weeks gestation. Enforcement predicated on success in Supreme Court of similar Mississippi law.

Yes(✓) = 81 No(X) = 9 Absent(A) = 15 LFF Supported. Status: Signed by the Governor

11. INTERNET GAMBLING ON FANTASY SPORTS TEAMS

HB 484 – Talbot – New form of gambling in La. based on “virtual” sports teams. Requires approval of voters in each parish in the fall election.

Yes(X) = 67 No(✓) = 23 Absent(A) = 15 LFF Opposed. Status: Signed by the Governor
