✔ HB 5 - FRIEMAN	Sent to Gov.	Provides for pregnancy-related medical expenses from the biological father
✔ HB 8 - HORTON	Sent to Gov.	"In God we Trust" motto in public school classrooms
✘ HB 9 - BUTLER	Deferred	Provides state funding for K - 12 students with exceptionalities not enrolled in public school
✘ HB 25 - HOLLIS	Failed	Local control and accountability over Library Boards
✔ HB 32 - SCHLEGEL	Sent to Gov.	Increases individual state income tax deduction for educational expenses
✔ HB 61 - SCHLEGEL	Sent to Gov.	Children must have parental permission to create an online account with a website
✔ HB 68 - HODGES	Signed By Gov. - Act 215	Allows for public school classes in the Bible as literature
✔ HB 77 - SCHLEGEL	Signed By Gov. Act 216	Protecting children on the Internet
✔ HB 81 - CREWS	Sent to Gov.	Provides relative to the use of certain names and pronouns for students
✘ HB 98 - L HARRIS	Deferred	Universal School Choice
✘ HB 152 - AMEDEE	Failed House Final Passage	Constitutionalizes the right of parents to nurture, educate, care, and control children
✔ HB 182 - EDMONSTON	Sent to Gov.	No COVID shot requirement for school attendance
✔ HB 260 - BEAULLIEU	Sent to Gov.	Prohibits federal interference in Louisiana elections
✔ HB 291 - C OWEN	Sent to Gov.	"No Patient Left Alone Law" - provides for in person visits at healthcare facilities even in Covid like emergencies
✔ HB 311 - MIGUEZ	Signed By Gov. - Act 200	Prohibits the use of funds and resources from a foreign government or nongovernmental source in Louisiana elections
✔ HB 399 - EDMONSTON	Sent to Gov.	Requires vaccine exemption information for incoming and attending students
✔ HB 415 - AMEDEE	Sent to Gov.	No Central Bank Digital Currency
✔ HB 443 - EDMONDS	Sent to Gov.	Adoption tax credit
✔ HB 457 - CREWS	Sent to Gov.	Certificate of non-viable birth for babies deceased in utero
✔ HB 462 - EDMONDS	Sent to Gov.	Fiscal accountability for school boards
✔ HB 466 - HORTON	Sent to Gov.	Prohibits K-12 from discussion of sexual orientation and gender identity and prohibits incorrect pronouns
✔ HB 648 - FIRMENT	Sent to Gov.	Establishes the "THE STOP HARMING OUR KIDS ACT" and prohibits procedures that attempt to alter the gender of minors
✔ SB 7 - CLOUD	Sent to Gov.	Requires that libraries limit students' access to sexually explicit material
✔ SB 41 - MIZELL	Sent to Gov.	Tax credit for donations to pregnancy resource centers
✔ SB 63 - MIZELL	On Ballot October, 2023	Constitutional amendment affirming freedom to worship is a fundamental right deserving the utmost protection from governmental interference

✓ SB 94 - KLEINPETER	Sent to Gov.	Regulation of Kratom
✓ SB 147 - R MILLS	Signed By Gov. - Act 259	Self-insurance fund for the purpose of providing property insurance coverage for churches and nonprofit religious organizations
✓ SB 175 - STINE	Sent to Gov.	Prohibits sexually explicit material depicting a minor using deepfake technology
✗ SB 194 - MIZELL	Bill Failed	Creates a civil cause of action for 18-20 year olds (or survivors) who sustain any injury or damages caused by underage intoxication
✓ SR 96 - MIZELL	Sent to Sec. of State	Requests the Department of Health to study long-term health events related to “medical marijuana”
✓ HB 17 - NEWELL	Bill Failed	Legalizes marijuana for recreational use
✓ HB 24 - NEWELL	Bill Failed	Decriminalization of marijuana possession and distribution
✓ HB 40 - BOYD	Bill Failed	Sexual orientation and gender identity protected in employment
✓ HB 165 - LANDRY	Bill Failed	Allows for initiatives, such as abortion, to be placed directly on the ballot for voter approval
✓ HB 228 - GREEN	Bill Failed	Eliminates the death penalty
✓ HB 306 - NEWELL	Withdrawn	Sex surveys allowed in Orleans parish public schools beginning in the 3rd grade
✓ HB 346 - BOYD	Bill Failed	Rape and incest exceptions to abortion laws
✓ HB 461 - DUBUISSON	Bill Failed	Abortion exceptions
✓ HB 522 - FREEMAN	Bill Failed	Decriminalizes abortion
✓ HB 549 - GLOVER	Bill Failed	Rape and incest exceptions to abortion laws
