HB 33	REP P DEVILLIER	Allows parents greater choice in children's education (state funded Education Savings Account would follow child to school of choice) Limited number of students would qualify. Also Support HB 452, SB 203, HB 227, HB 194, HB 526, HB 824 and HB 838.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Education	SUPPORT
HB 37	REP D MCCORMICK	Removes the requirement that a person possess a permit issued by the state of LA in order to carry a concealed handgun.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Judiciary C	SUPPORT
HB 80	REP R EDMONDS	Conservative method of planning state budget. Limits proposed expenditures to 98% of projected revenue. Creates a buffer of savings for state spending.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Finance	SUPPORT
HB 142	REP L SCHLEGEL	Protecting children from harmful material on the internet.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Judiciary A	SUPPORT
HB 146	REP C OWEN	Prevents forced abortion on a woman who is unable to give consent.	Notice given subject to call - House final passage	SUPPORT
HB 234	REP L SCHLEGEL	No smoking or vaping marijuana in any form while driving or riding in a motor vehicle.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Transportation	SUPPORT
HB 274	REP R EDMONDS	Expands the information required to be provided in adoption awareness instruction for high school students.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Education	SUPPORT
HB 356	REP B AMEDEE	Adds lessons to the instructional materials parents are entitled to access and adds the examination of lessons to the Parents' Bill of Rights.	Pending House final passage - 05/12/22	SUPPORT
HB 459	REP C OWEN	End of life protections to provide care as requested by patient or patient's representative.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Health and Welfare	SUPPORT
HB 526	REP R EDMONDS	Fiscal transparency and accountability for school boards.	Pending House floor action	SUPPORT

HB 993	REP EDMONDS	Provides the right of marriage and family therapists to decline counseling services that violate their conscience.	Pending House Commerce	SUPPORT
HCR 3	REP L BAGLEY	Repeals state requirements for children to receive COVID vaccine as a condition of school enrollment.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Health and Welfare	SUPPORT
SB 44	SEN B MIZELL	Prohibits a team designated for females, girls, or women from being open to students who are not biologically female.	Passed the Senate; Pending House final passage	SUPPORT
SB 104	SEN MIZELL	Would prohibit abortion facilities from preventing patient communication with others outside the facility.	Passed the Senate; Pending House Health and Welfare - 05/11/22	SUPPORT
SB 131	SEN B MIZELL	Colleges and other postsecondary institutions must block access to pornographic and sexually harassing material.	Passed the Senate; Pending House Education - 05/10/22	SUPPORT
SB 148	SEN MIZELL	Victims of trafficking can apply for set aside of convictions on certain crimes committed while they were being trafficked.	Passed the Senate; Pending House final passage	SUPPORT
SB 226	SEN H CLOUD	Better enforcement of election offenses.	Pending Senate and Governmental Affairs	SUPPORT
SB 342	SEN K JACKSON	Helps to ensure that Louisiana abortion laws, including laws which would prohibit abortion, are properly framed for a post-Roe Louisiana should Roe v Wade be overturned or modified by the Supreme Court.	Passed the Senate; Pending House Health and Welfare - 05/11/22	SUPPORT
SB 388	SEN S HEWITT	Selling mail order abortion drugs a felony.	Passed the Senate; Pending House Health and Welfare - 05/11/22	SUPPORT

HB 125	REP C NEWELL	Legalizes marijuana sales and distribution to most of the public. See also HB 430 by Rep. Green.	Failed in House Judiciary	OPPOSE
HB 209	REP M LANDRY	Allows certain parishes to adopt ordinances more restrictive than state law regarding sale and ownership of firearms. Would override state more effective policies.	Failed in House Criminal Justice Committee	OPPOSE
HB 303	REP A FREEMAN	Prohibits housing discrimination based on sexual orientation and gender identity.	Notice given subject to call - House final passage - 05/11/22	OPPOSE
HB 439	REP D BOYD	Prohibits employment discrimination based on sexual orientation and gender identity.	Pending House Labor and Industrial Relations - 05/12/22	OPPOSE
HB 450	REP C OWEN	Would allow a person who is adopted and who is older than 24 years of age to request an uncertified copy of original birth certificate even if birthmother had an expectation of confidentiality.	Passed the House; Pending Senate Judiciary A	OPPOSE
HB 493	REP T JOHNSON	Changes the maximum number of video poker devices from three to nine at establishments licensed to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises. LFF will continue to oppose expansion or deregulation of gambling,	Pending House Administration of Criminal Justice	OPPOSE
HB 605	REP M LANDRY	Prohibits any attempts to assist minors in dealing with unwanted same sex attractions. Violation of the religious freedom of health care providers.	Failed in House Health and Welfare	OPPOSE
HCR 64	REP FREEMAN	Abortion industry on the attack against crisis pregnancy centers in our state.	Notice given subject to call - House final passage - 05/11/22	OPPOSE
SB 294	SEN JACKSON	With HB 106 , eliminates the death penalty as a possible punishment for the offenses of first degree murder, first degree rape, and treason.	Failed in Senate Judiciary C	OPPOSE
HB 813	REP MCCORMICK	Enacts the Abolition of Abortion in Louisiana Act of 2022. Define "person" as including a human being from the moment of fertilization. Protects life of every "person".	Pending House final passage - 05/12/22	MONITOR
